

Baptismal Vows of the Movement of the High Sabbath Adventists

1. Do you believe in the existence of one God: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, which constitute a unity of three eternal Persons?
2. Do you accept Jesus Christ's death on Calvary as the atoning sacrifice for your sins and believe that by the grace of God, through faith in His shed blood, you are saved from sin and its penalty?
3. Do you accept Jesus Christ as your personal Lord and Savior, believing that God in Christ has forgiven your sins and given you a new heart, which renounces the sinful ways of the world?
4. Do you accept by faith the righteousness of Christ, recognizing him as your Advocate in the heavenly sanctuary, and accept the promise that says that God will give grace and transforming power to live a life centered in Christ and love, both at home and before the world?
5. Do you believe the Bible is the inspired Word of God, and is the only rule of faith and practice for Christians? Do you undertake to regularly devote time to prayer and Bible study?
6. Do you agree that the Ten Commandments are an expression of God's character, and that they reveal His will? If so, do you purpose, by the power of Christ's presence in your heart, to keep this law, including the fourth commandment, which requires us to observe the seventh day of the week as the Sabbath of the Lord and as a memorial to creation and His seal of marriage, agreeing that it is very good as God created it? Do you believe that the Sabbath should be kept only in an eternal rhythm of seven days and that it is not dependent on the phases of the moon?
7. Do you believe that Christ came in the fallen flesh of Adam, was tempted like us in all points, and had no advantage over us for keeping the commandments? Do you believe that Christ experienced exactly the same temptations as we do?
8. Do you long for the soon coming of Jesus, which Paul calls the blessed hope when "this mortal shall put on immortality"? Is your purpose to personally prepare to meet with the Lord, and at the same time, make every effort to bear witness to His loving salvation by using your talents in personal effort to win souls and to help others prepare for his glorious appearing?
9. Do you accept the biblical teaching of spiritual gifts and believe that the gift of prophecy is one of the identifying marks of the remnant church?
10. Do you believe in the movement of the Fourth Angel of Revelation 18, which lightens the earth with His glory and sounds the loud cry with the last warning to the world in the seven last trumpets and their accompanying signs in heaven? Do you believe in the Message of the High Sabbath Adventists, which is expressed in Orion, the Vessel of Time, and the Consequences for the Universe and God Himself, and do you intend to worship God in the heavenly sanctuary and support the movement with your tithes and offerings, as well as your personal effort and influence?
11. Do you believe the body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, and that it is your duty to honor God by taking care of it, avoiding the use of all that is harmful, practicing total abstinence from eating unclean foods; the use, manufacture or sale of alcoholic beverages and tobacco, in any form for human consumption;

and the abuse or misuse and trafficking of narcotics or other drugs? Will you commit to live according to the health message of Christ's right arm and keep a meatless diet as a lacto-ovo vegetarian or even vegan?

12. Knowing the fundamental biblical principles, and understanding how the movements of the first, second, third and fourth angels are teaching them, is it your purpose, by the grace of God, to do His will by ordering your life according to these principles?

13. Do you vow to witness for the Father through faithfulness to His law, whether in life as one of the 144,000 or in death as a martyr, even offering our eternal life, if it is needed?

14. Do you accept the New Testament teaching about baptism by immersion, and want to be baptized this way as a public demonstration of your faith in Christ and forgiveness of sins?

Do you believe that the Movement of the High Sabbath Adventists is where God has given the means of preparation for the 144,000 to bear witness to the Father and His righteousness in front of the whole universe? Do you want to become a member of the Global Movement of the High Sabbath Adventists?
